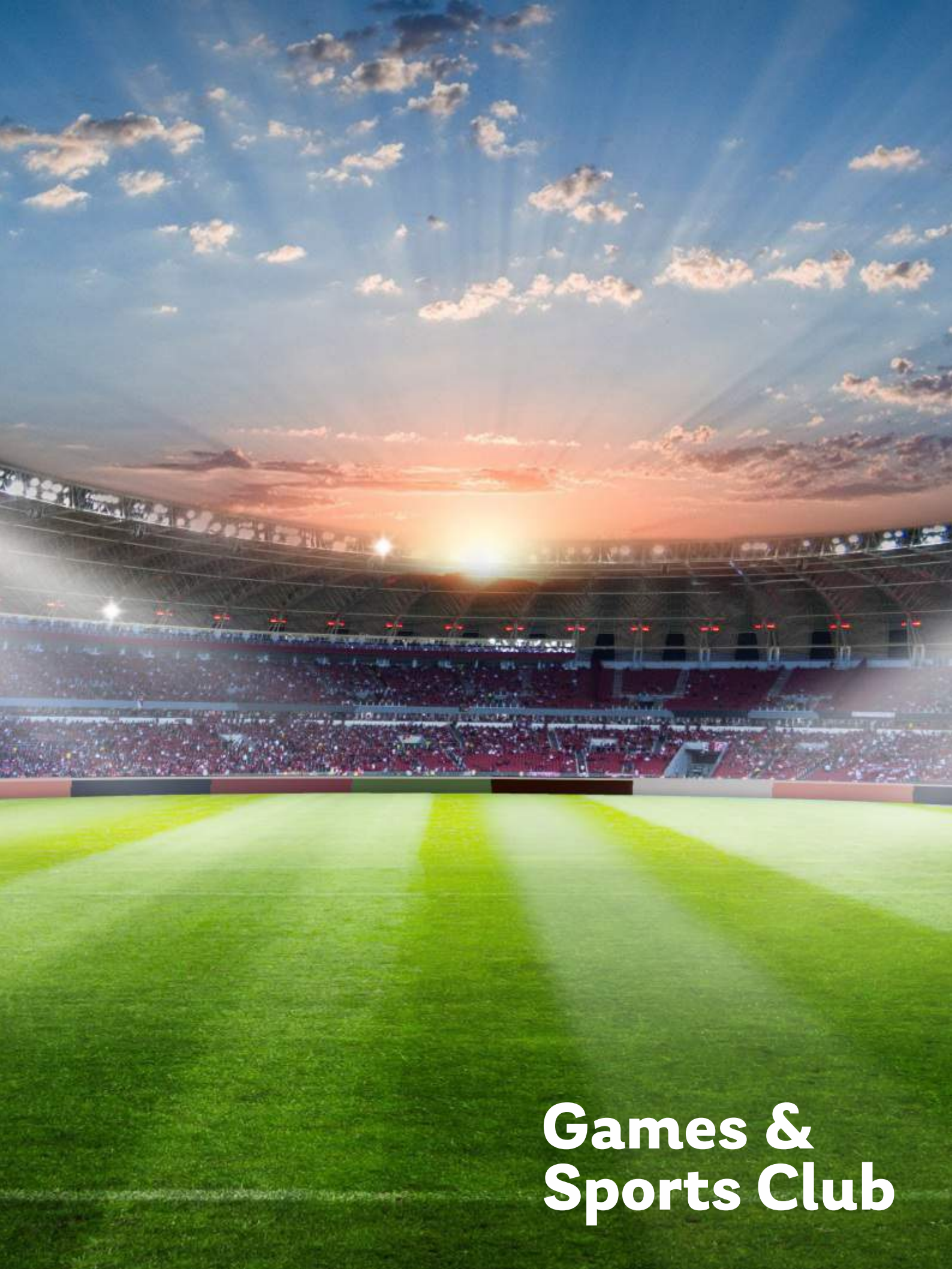


Inauguration of Solidarity Games & Sports Club

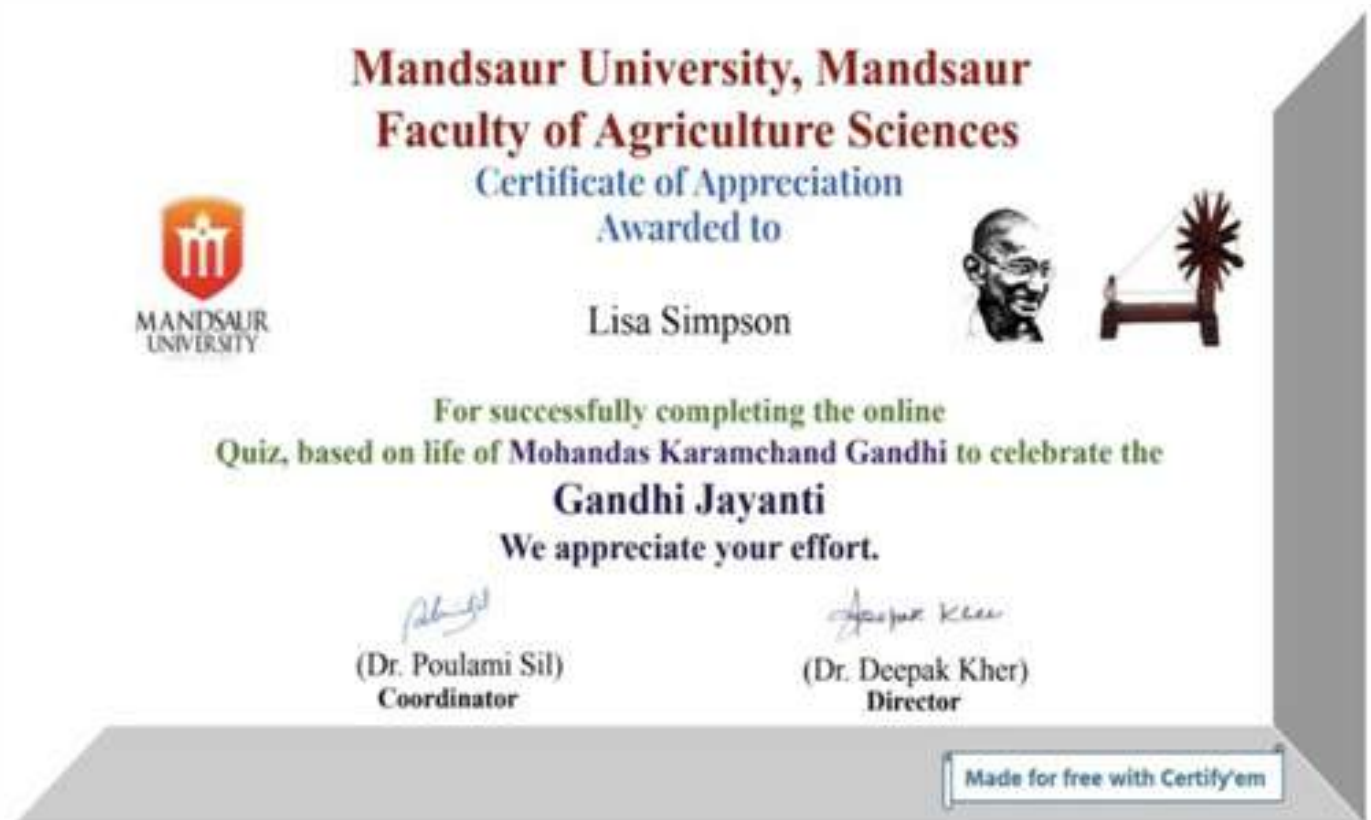

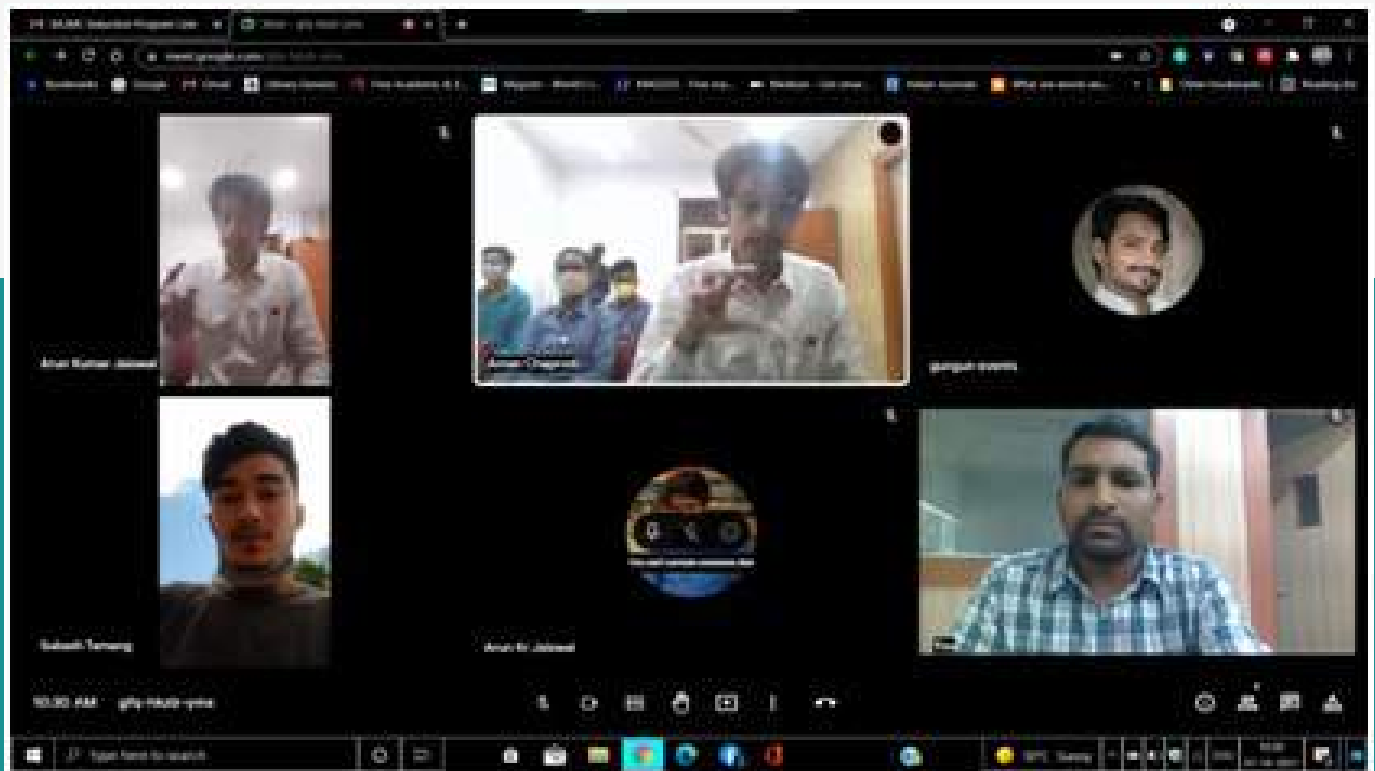
