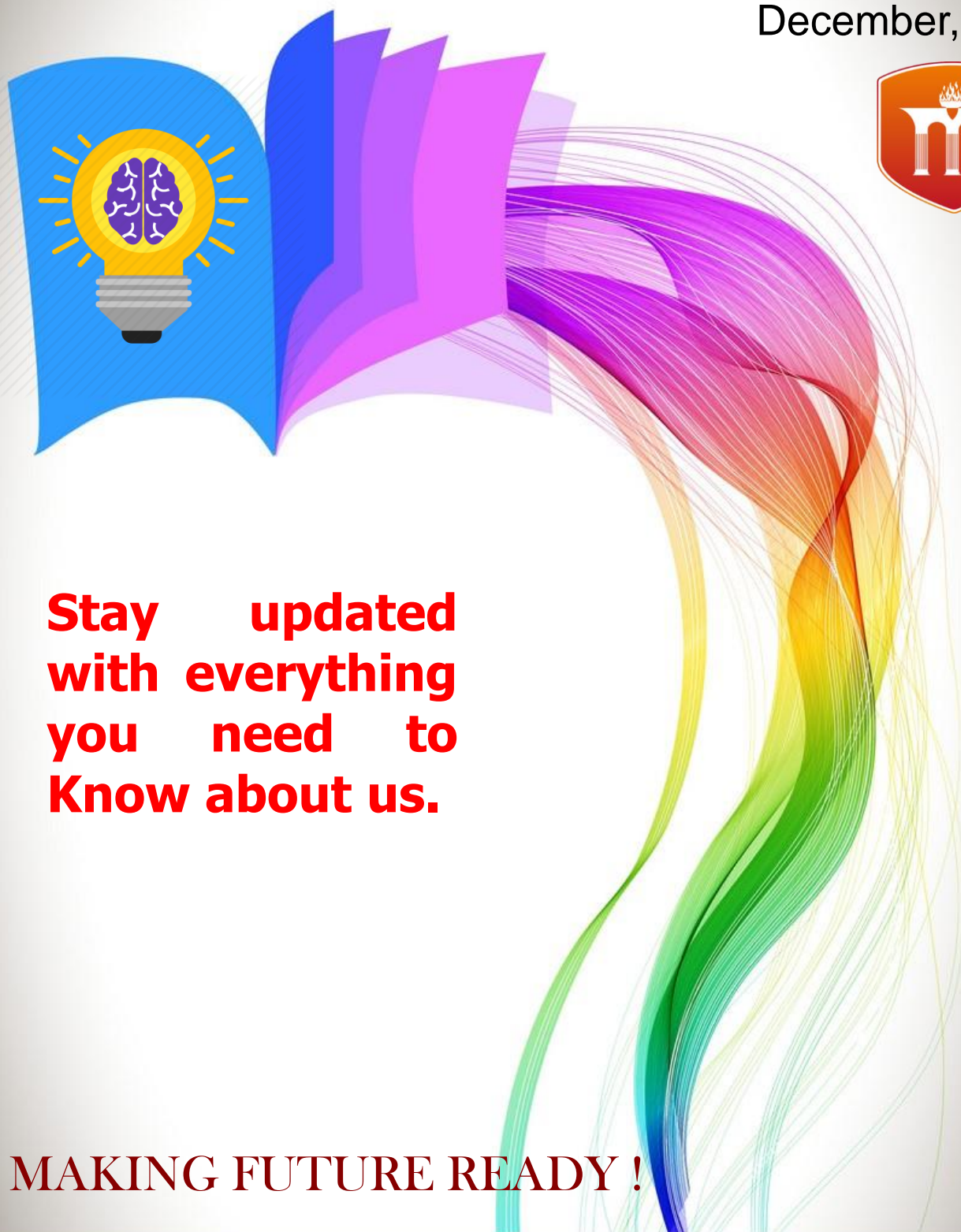


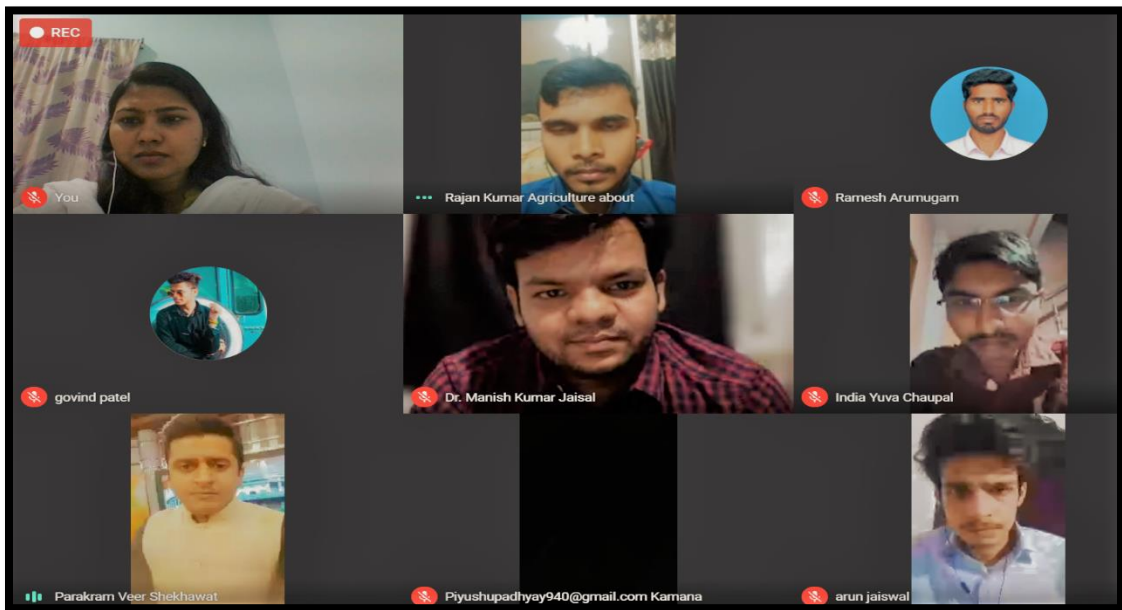

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## OPPORTUNITIES AND CHALLENGES IN TV JOURNALISM

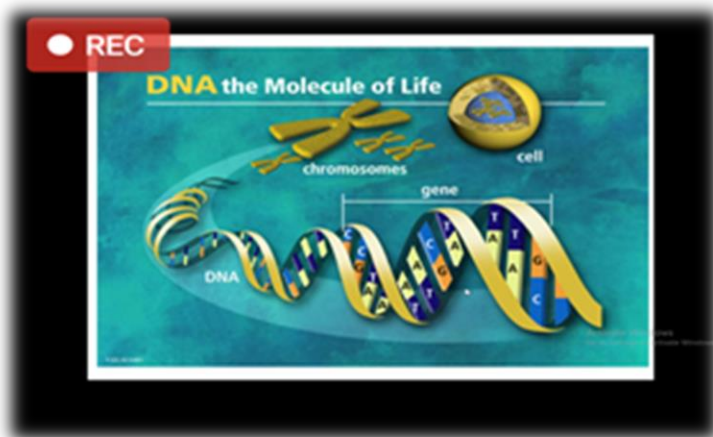

**“Polymerase chain reaction (PCR)” including role of Polymerase enzyme, gene amplification.**



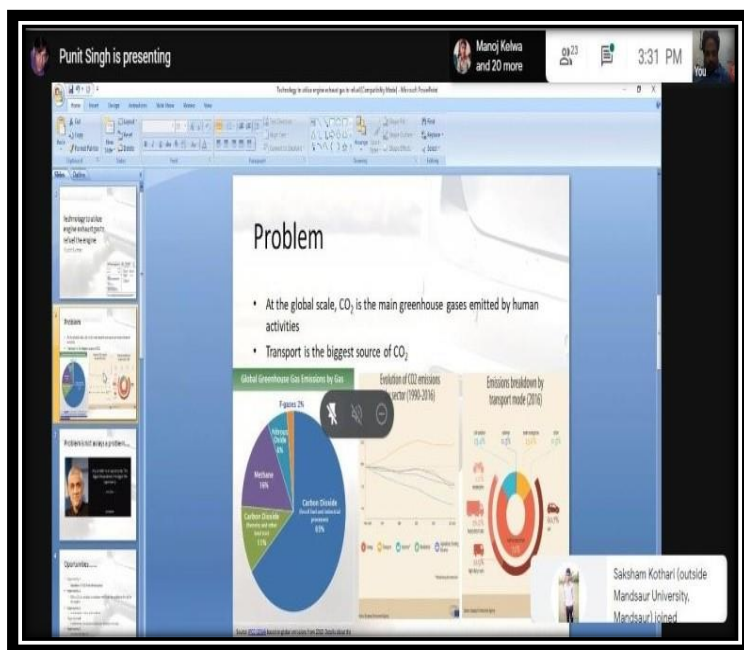

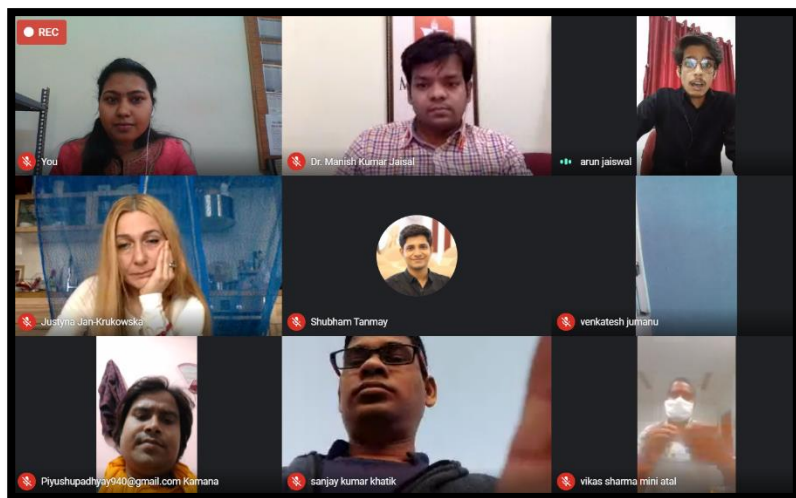
## GUEST LECTURE ON ADVANCEMENT IN AUTOMOTIVE INDUSTRY
