

Junior Research Fellowships (JRF) & Senior Research Fellowships (SRF)

MANDSAUR UNIVERSITY, MANDSAUR

Mandsaur University has a large pool of Ph.D. scholars who need to channelize their energy and efforts by undertaking quality research work which should be applicable to the society and for nation building. Apart from the self-financed Ph.D. scholars, the University supports the Ph.D. degree seeking scholars financially by extending financial assistance. Mandsaur University approved the rules and regulation of fellowship for Junior Research Fellowship/Senior Research Fellowship under Research programmes/ Projects under Mandsaur University. The fellowship amount is given as under:

1	Junior Research Fellowship (JRF)	Rs. 21, 600/- Per Month	Additional Seed Money of Rs. 100000/- to meet the expenditure of research work. Sanction of this amount shall be in the purview of MURC Policy of Mandsaur University.
2	Senior Research Fellowship (SRF)	Rs. 25, 600/- Per Month	

Terms & Conditions:

1. MU approved supervisor needs to present the proposal of research to the committee.
2. JRF would be given only in condition if he or she will register full time Ph. D. programme immediately.
3. If the fellow is registered for PhD within the stipulated period, then on completion of two years as JRF, he/she will be required to submit the work/progress report within six months for upgradation to SRF. On the basis of assessment of Fellows' research progress/ achievements through interview by an Expert Committee consisting of the Guide, Head of the Department and External Member from outside the University/Institution who is an expert in the relevant field, not below the rank of Professor/Associate Professor and on the recommendation of



the said expert committee, the JRF will be upgraded to the position of SRF on the monthly stipend of Rs. 25,600/- for the 3rd and subsequent years. As far as possible the External Member should be the chairman of three members Committee.

4. Need to submit the utilization certificate and progress report biannually.
5. Preference will be given to **NET/ SLET/GPAT/GATE** or equivalent candidates.
6. The research scholar under this "JRF & SRF Fellowship" shall be required to publish at 02 Research papers in Scopus/ WOS indexed journals per year.
7. If he or she discontinued Ph. D. programme then JRF/SRF fellowship will be discontinued.
8. JRF/SRF Fellowship is provided to a limited number of fulltime Ph.D. registered candidates in the University.
