General Rules of the Event:

- 1. All the participants are required to get themselves registered for the event through the link provided https://forms.gle/8KMvYACuX9GaE5qc9
- 2. The last date for event registrations is 15th May 2024 till 11:59 pm.
- 3. The last date to submit the content of online competitions through the link embedded here (Reel, Photography, Shortfilms) is 15th May, 2024.
- 4. The decision of Jury members will be final. Clarifications regarding the judgment will not be entertained.
- 5. E-certificates will be provided to all the participants.
- 6. A student can participate in a maximum of 3 sub-events.
- 7. Online registration is a must for each and every competition.
- 8. No Entry will be entertained without the Google form registration.
- 9. The Winner, will get a trophy and certificate of appreciation in each competition.

Note: Winners are required to present on 17th May physically to receive the award/trophy/certificates/Prices at JMC Dept Mandsaur University. In failing to present physically the next position will be the winner and will receive the award.

Rules for News Anchoring

- 1. Participants are required to register before the competition to be eligible.
- 2. Each Institute/College/University can submit only one entry.
- 3. The competition will be conducted offline.
- 4. The competition consists of two rounds. The first round requires participants to prepare for a recent event from National and International, Regional, Political, Entertainment, or Sports domains.
- 5. The second round involves judges assigning a random topic to the participants.
- 6. Participants will be judged based on content quality, language proficiency, pronunciation, and presentation skills.
- 7. Each participant has a maximum of 120 seconds for their presentation.
- 8. Participants can choose to present in either Hindi or English.

Disqualification Criteria:

- Use of profanity in any form.
- Exceeding the specified time limit.

Rules for Reel Making Competition

Rules and Regulations:

- The theme is 'Campus life, Education, Culture and Unemployment'
- Reels can be made of 30 to 60 seconds time duration.
- Opening & closing credits are not required.
- Reels can be created either in Hindi, English, Malwa or with no language as well.
- Content must be original. Copyright violation is not allowed.

- The aspect ratio should be 9:16.
- The caption provided by the participants should be less than 140 characters.
- The videos in no manner should contain any content which showcases hatred towards any religion or community, gender, caste, or political oriented vibe in any form. Double meaning or adult content will not be entertained and would lead to direct disqualification.
- Submissions must be made by the deadline (15th May 2024) in a compatible video format through the google form link https://forms.gle/hgF9jotyXZ1BBvq8A
